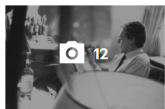

Spoof celebrity lookalike photos give hilarious glimpse into politics in 2016

A hilarious new series of spoof photos have given a glimpse into what this year might have been like for some of the biggest political celebrities.

Donald Trump surrounded by the Klu Klux Klan, [Boris Johnson](#) fixing a bike and [Nigel Farage](#) bouncing on a space hopper are just some of the scenes pictured in a new book by a London artist.

The collection, published by award-winning creator Alison Jackson, uses celebrity lookalikes to stage funny and realistic photographs based on current affairs.

The snaps include [Tony Blair](#) doodling on a copy of the Chilcot report, Francois Hollande feeding Angela Merkel a croissant in bed and Nigel Farage uncorking a bottle of champers with Donald Trump.
