The Duke and Duchess of Sussex have remained relatively tight lipped when it comes to their pregnancy, with royal watchers left guessing on how the couple will prepare for their new arrival.

But new photos appear to offer a little insight into the couple's pre-natal prep - as imagined by celebrity spoof photographer Alison Jackson anyway.

Jackson is well known for mocking up pictures of the royals, with their lookalikes standing in.

Her latest series sees very convincing Harry and Meghan lookalikes play out how the couple might be spending their last couple of months before the birth - including picking out baby clothes and prenatal yoga.

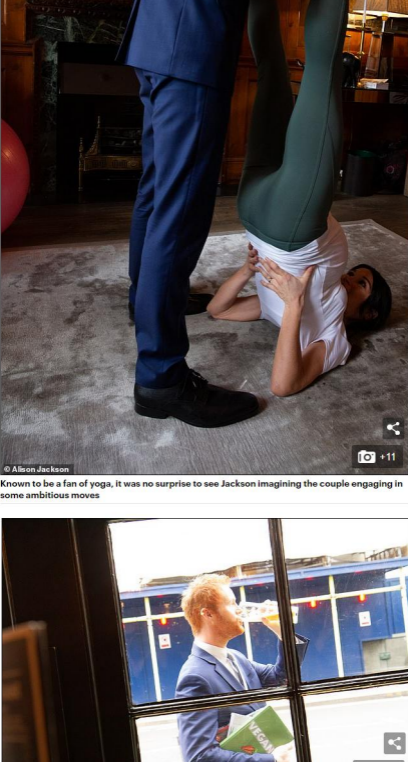
The pictures also see 'Harry' playing the dutiful husband, trying to listen to the babies heartbeat, and in another snap the actor is seen measuring her baby bump.



The pictures also see Harry being the dutiful husband, trying to listen to the babies heartbeat (pictured) while Meghan lies down and also one of him measuring her baby bump



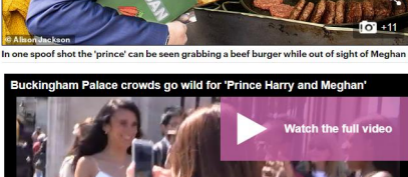

Known to be a fan of yoga, it was no surprise to see Jackson imagining the couple engaging in some ambitious moves



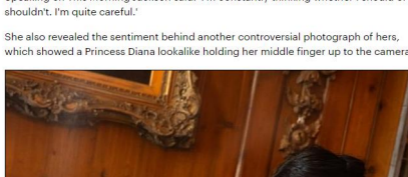
Jackson snapped a tongue in cheek shot of the 'Duke' downing a pint while his 'wife' was out of sight

But they also look at what Harry might get up to when Meghan isn't around too - including sneakily having a pint and also eating a greasy burger while clutching a book on veganism.

Talking about her pictures earlier this week the photographer said her snaps had previously got her into trouble.

Speaking on This Morning Jackson said: 'I'm constantly thinking whether I should or shouldn't. I'm quite careful.'

She also revealed the sentiment behind another controversial photograph of hers, which showed a Princess Diana lookalike holding her middle finger up to the camera.

'She was chased all the time by the press and the public. We had a need to see her more and more and more,' Jackson said.

'How did she feel about all of that? The photo shows her [lookalike] with her middle finger up - it was a "that's to you guys for chasing me around".'

Jackson has previously imagined a pregnant Kate and William ahead of Prince George's birth.

The images saw the lookalikes on a birthing ball and with 'Pippa Middleton' joining her pregnant sister exercising by hula hooping.

Jackson's new show Double Fake starts at the Leicester Square Theatre on the 5th March.
